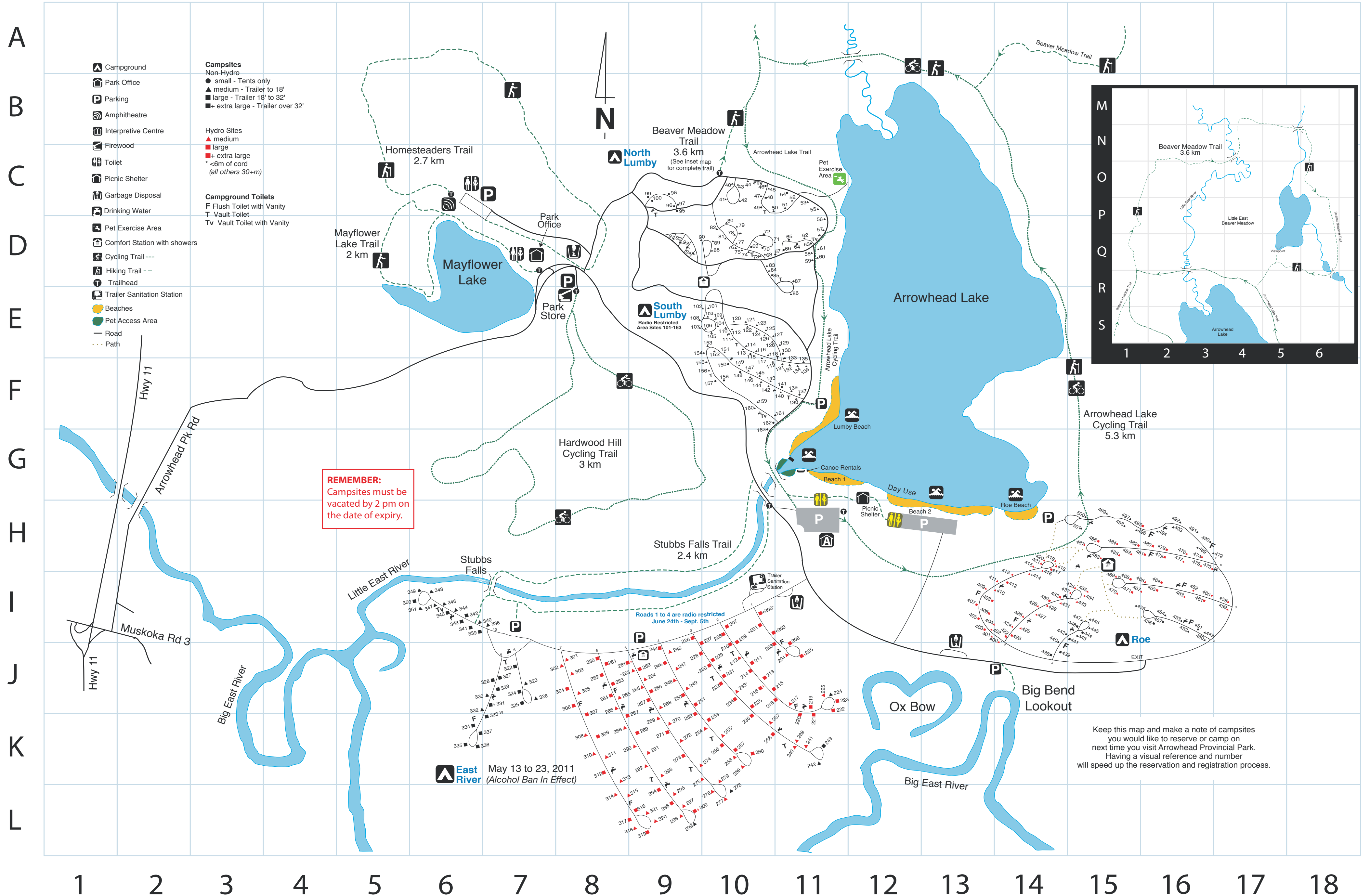


Arrowhead Provincial Park Map

Cross-country Skiing

Arrowhead offers 28 km of classic ski trails and 11 km of skate ski trails that range from beginner to expert.

Snowshoeing

Over 8 km of marked snowshoe trails, as well as off-trail snowshoeing through mature hardwood forests.

Tubing Hill

Free with your vehicle pass. We supply the tubes. Plan a tubing party!

Warm up Shelters

Two heated shelters are available for you to unwind in or have lunch and enjoy the fire inside.

Skating

Arrowhead's Ice trail is even better than last year. The 1.1km loop through the forest will be lit with tiki torches on special nights. Check in with us to find out when. Our regular rink is now adjacent to the Ice Trail. Play a little Shinny!

Caution

Trails are not patrolled or checked at park close. Please exit trails 15 minutes before closing.

Skiers' Responsibility Code:

1. Always check the posted trail conditions. These trails are not supervised. Use extra caution during changing weather, icy conditions, or on steep hills.
2. Ski in the indicated direction and obey all posted signs and warnings. Keep off closed trails.
3. Always ski to the right when meeting on-coming skiers and when skiing double track.
4. Yield the track to faster skiers and skiers calling "TRACK".
5. Ski in control. On two-way trails descending skiers have the right-of way.
6. Do not stop where you obstruct the trail or are not visible to others. Move off the track quickly if you fall or during rest stops.
7. Do not litter. Take out what you pack in. Respect all property.
8. Pets, hiking, snowshoeing, and toboggans are not permitted on ski trails.
9. Travel over any of Arrowhead Park's lakes, rivers or streams is not recommended.

Getting Here:

7 kilometres north of Huntsville off Hwy 11 Exit 226, turn right to Arrowhead Park Road.

Please Note: All vehicles entering the park must obtain and display a valid park permit. A vehicle permit entitles occupants of the vehicle to use all our facilities except for ski trails. If one or more of your party intends to ski, a trail pass will be required for each skier. A vehicle permit is provided at no additional charge with the purchase of a ski trail pass.
